**Bulgaria:** 2 regions of Severoiztochen, Yugoiztochen;  
**Grecia:** regions of Kentriki Makedonia, Anatoliki Makedonia Thraki;  
**Romania:** region of South-East;  
**Turcia:** regions of TR10 (İstanbul), TR21 (Tekirdağ, Edirne, Kırklareli), TR42 (Kocaeli, Sakarya, Düzce, Bolu, Yalova), TR81 (Zonguldak, Karabük, Bartın), TR82 (Kastamonu, Çankırı, Sinop), TR83 (Samsun, Tokat, Çorum, Amasya) and TR90 (Trabzon, Ordu, Giresun, Rize, Artvin, Gümüşhane);  
**Ucraina\*:** Odesa, Mykolaiv, Kherson, Zaporosh'ye and Donetsk Oblasts, Crimea Republic, Sevastopol;  
**Rep. Moldova, Georgia, Armenia:** whole country.

<b>Legal status</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• regional, local public authority or national public authority</li><li>• bodies governed by public law</li><li>• non-profit organisations (NGO)</li></ul>
<b>Partnership</b>	<p>Minimum - 3 partners from different countries Maximum - 6 partners including the Lead Partner</p> <p>Partners - from at least 1 EU MS and 1 CBC partner country</p> <p>Participation of Turkish partners – in projects with at least 1 partner from a EU MS and 1 partner from a CBC partner country</p>
<b>Size of grants</b>	Max. 1 500 000 Euro
<b>Project duration</b>	Max. 30 months
