Considering the negative fluctuation of the US dollar exchange rate against other currencies amounting to -141,89 mln. US dollars, the external central government debt outstanding as of April 30, 2022 has decreased by 70,68 mln. US dollars or 2,82%, compared with the external central government debt outstanding as of January 01, 2022.
