Note: During the first four months of the 2023, the external net financing reached a positive value representing 254,75 mln. US dollars. Considering the positive fluctuation of the US dollar exchange rate against other currencies amounting to 84,40 mln. US dollars, the external central government debt outstanding as of April 30, 2023 has increased by 339,16 mln. US dollars or 10,80%, compared with the external central government debt outstanding as of January 01, 2023.
