Note: During the first eight months of the 2022, the external net financing reached a positive value representing 455,27 mln. US dollars. Considering the negative fluctuation of the US dollar exchange rate against other currencies amounting to -235,85 mln. US dollars, the external central government debt outstanding as of August 31, 2022 has increased by 219,42 mln. US dollars or 8,76%, compared with the external central government debt outstanding as of January 01, 2022.
